



BSC AI Factory – Incubation Program

Resolution of Call 2

Final Resolution – Amendment 1

Date of issue: 7 April 2026 | Amendment date: 4 June 2026

In accordance with the timeline established for **Call 2 of the BSC AI Factory Incubation Space**, a total of **59 applications** were received across the four Incubation Sites.

The procedure consisted of two stages:

1. **Eligibility Screening:** All 59 submitted applications were assessed to verify compliance with the mandatory eligibility criteria set out in Article 3 of the Rules for Participation. All applications were found to fulfil the required criteria and were admitted to the subsequent stage.
2. **External Evaluation:** For all of the Incubation Sites a competitive evaluation was conducted by an independent external evaluator, external to the Organizer and the BSC AI Factory Consortium, in accordance with Article 6.4. Applications were assessed against the five evaluation criteria defined in Article 6.5 and ranked per site.

Following the notification period, a number of provisionally selected Applicants either withdrew or declined the offer. In accordance with Article 6.7, vacant positions were offered to the next highest-ranked Applicant on the corresponding Site-specific Waiting List. The tables below reflect the final confirmed results, including all withdrawals and replacements.

Upon completion of the full selection and acceptance procedure, it is hereby resolved that **28 companies** have confirmed their participation as Beneficiaries under Call 2 of the BSC AI Factory Incubation Program, distributed as follows: **20 in Barcelona (Spain), 4 in Guimarães (Portugal), 2 in Lisbon (Portugal), and 2 in Bucharest (Romania).**

1. Incubation Site: Pier 07, Barcelona, Spain

A total of 47 eligible applications were received for the Barcelona Incubation Site (up to 20 Participants). A competitive evaluation was conducted in accordance with Article 6.4. Following notification, **VitalizeDx** and **SignForDeaf** withdrew from the program. In accordance with Article 6.7, their places were filled by **Numerand** and **Bybusiness AI** from the Waiting List. Subsequently, **Numerand** ceased operations and withdrew from the programme. In accordance with Article 6.7, the vacant position was offered to the next highest-ranked applicant on the Waiting List, **EasyMed (EASYMEDAI MEDICAL DATA S.L.)**, who accepted and joined the programme for the remainder of Call 2.

5. Notification, Acceptance and Appeals

All candidates were formally notified by email of their selection outcome. In accordance with Article 7.2, selected Applicants were granted **five (5) working days** from the date of notification to formally accept or decline the offer. Failure to formally accept within this period was construed as a definitive rejection.

To accept, applicants were required to reply to the official email, **signing the Rules for Participation and providing the necessary documentation** with all information about the participants in the Incubation Program.

In accordance with Article 7.3, Applicants who disagree with the outcome may submit a formal written appeal within **five (5) working days** from the date of notification. The Organizer shall issue a reasoned response within ten (10) working days. The submission of an appeal does not suspend the execution of the Incubation Program.

This resolution is issued as formal accreditation that the selection process for Call 2 of the BSC AI Factory Incubation Program has been executed in full compliance with the Rules for Participation and under principles of transparency, legality, and fairness. This document incorporates the final acceptance outcomes and constitutes the definitive list of confirmed Participants for the Batch running from 1 April 2026 to 30 September 2026. This Amendment 1, issued on 4 June 2026, reflects the withdrawal of Numerand due to company closure and the consequent incorporation of EasyMed (EASYMEDAI MEDICAL DATA S.L.) as a Beneficiary for the remainder of Call 2, in accordance with Article 6.7 of the Rules for Participation.
